This wine is a perfect white to be enjoyed year-round.

The palate is silky and expansive with a shimmering mineral character and a long, pure finish. It improved over the two to three days it was open and will benefit from a long decant.

Louis Jadot Macon Villages	Chardonnay	Burgundy, France	2023	\$28	Bright white flower, apple and citrus aromas and bracing, fresh, clean fruit on the palate, with mineral notes.
Toad Hollow	Chardonnay	Mendocino, California	2022	\$26	This medium-bodied wine offers a lively feel and lots of fresh fruit tones. Flavors of lemon and fresh apple are settled and pure on the crisp palate.

Medium-weight, with a nice crisp acidity, this wine strikes the perfect balance between warm oak creaminess and bright juicy fruit.

However, don't let that fool you as this is a superb white Bordeaux made by Chateau Croix de Labrie in St Emilion. Rich and round with a core of exotic fruit and integrated oak. This is well worth a try!

Terra Valentine	Sauvignon Blanc	Sonoma County, California	2018	\$41	Floral, flinty and well balanced, with nice structure, this is a well-made white brimming in apricot and lime whose label states stainless-steel fermentation was used. It shows classic flavor and fleshy texture with length and decent depth.
Kobal	Sauvignon Blanc	Slovenia	2021	\$32	Lemongrass, grapefruit peel, and gardenia. The wine delivers a beautifully layered structure on the palate, lively but juicy of lychee, spiced grapefruit, lifted by zesty acidity.
